We're also kicking off exciting projects across the city, including improvements at **East Roswell Park**. Construction is set to begin soon, bringing:


- A new dog park with improved parking

ONLINE REGISTRATION

IN-PERSON REGISTRATION

Prefer to register in person? Visit Roswell City Hall at 38 Hill Street, Suite 100, Roswell, GA 30075, Monday through Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM. On the first day of registration (see dates above), numbered tickets will be distributed starting at 8 AM, with registration beginning at 9 AM. Please bring proof of residency if applicable and have your preferred camp selections ready.

Refund & Class Change Requests

CAMP REFUNDS

- A minimum \$10 handling fee will be charged on all refund requests.
- Refund requests submitted more than 30 days before the start date of camp will receive a 100% refund minus the \$10 handling fee. Refund requests submitted 14- 29 days before the start date of the camp will receive a 50% refund minus \$10 handling fee.
- Camp transfer requests submitted more than 30 days before the start of the program are dependent on program availability. Camp transfers requested less than 30 days before the start of the camp will not be accepted.
- Refund/transfer requests submitted 13 days or less before the start date will not receive a refund or transfer.

MEDICAL ISSUES

- A letter from a licensed physician setting forth the participant's physical reason for being unable to participate in the program or camp must accompany any refund request based on medical issues. Participants with medical requests meeting this criterion will receive an account credit for the time the participant is unable to participate in the program or camp.

PROCESSING FEES

Payment Notice: Please note: a 3% processing fee will be applied to all electronic payments online or in person including credit card, debit card, online bank drafts (e-check).

In the case of installment billing, the initial payment will include a 3% fee for the total amount.
